Checked Baggage

## Passenger Ticket and Baggage Check

Limits of liability: The applicable limits of liability for your journey on a flight operated by a carrier of the SAS Group are as follows:

\* In the case of destruction, loss of, or damage or delay to baggage, 1,131 Special Drawing Rights, and if the value of your baggage is greater than this limit, you should inform the carrier at check-in or ensure that it is fully insured prior to travel; and

\* In case of delay to your journey, 4694 Special Drawing Rights. If your journey also involves carriage by airlines that are not part of the SAS Group, you should contact them for information on their liability.
